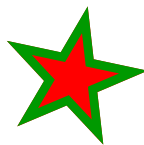

We will provide a sound system in the practice room as well as for the competition floor. Bring CD please and have a back up copy available. Make sure music is at the DJ booth 10 minutes before you perform.

Misc. Information

Spring floor event— 42 x 54 standard size 2 minutes and 30 seconds max music time. Illegal skills based on choreography –10 pt deduction. Participant error—5 pt deduction. Each team will be allowed 20 minutes in the practice room. No stunting in the lobby area or hallways please! Dance teams will perform on Spring floor as well.
